

# TOP LEVEL FREEDOM COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

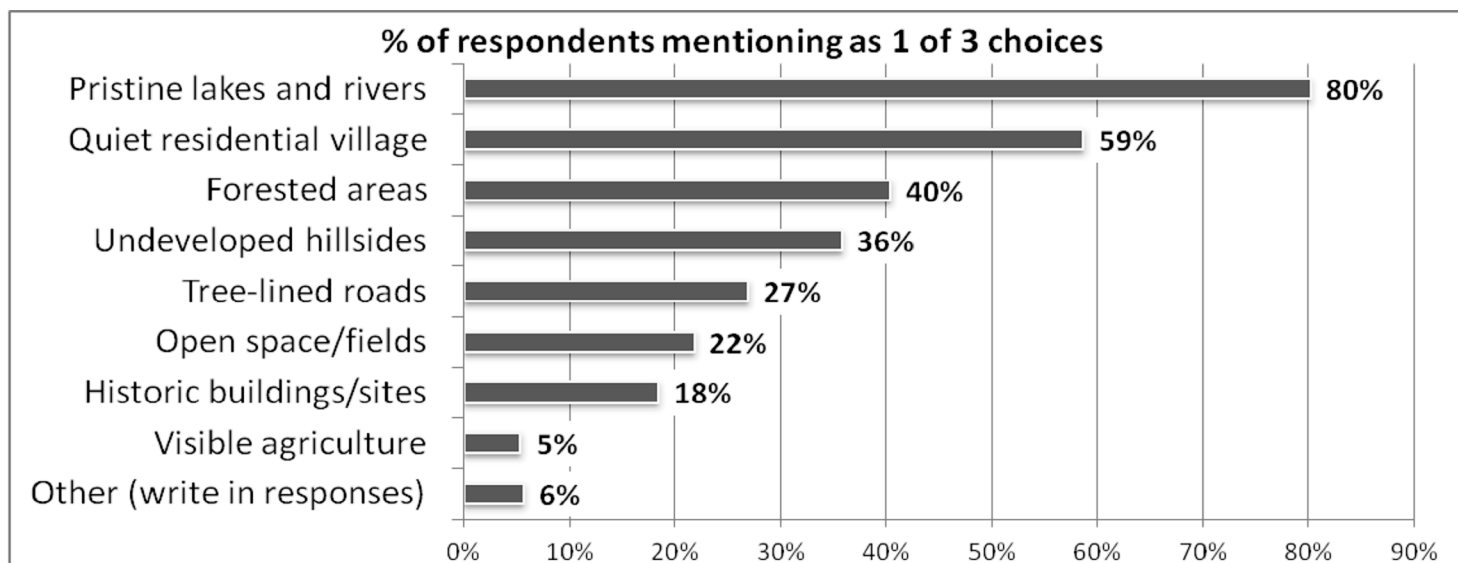
## Community Survey Results:

- This document shows the top level responses to the community survey. It follows the survey questions (pages 1-6) and provides the detail on the respondents (page 7).
- More detailed information, showing differences between sub groups- e.g.; seasonal versus year round respondents, property location (on the water, with deeded water access, or no water access), and distance from village (in or within 1 mile or greater than 1 mile)- is located on the town website as %Detailed Community Survey Results 11.19.2015.+ This provides greater insight into the results. It also discusses themes, e.g. water resources, rural character, senior services, to name a few.

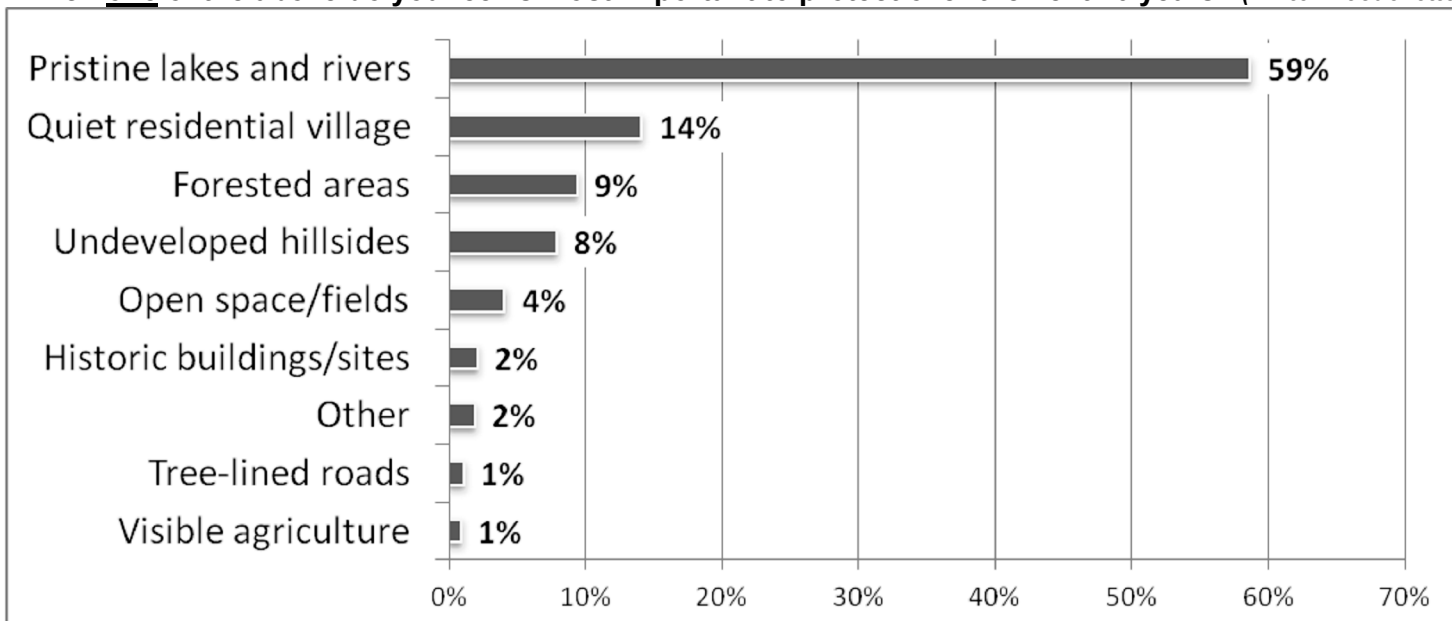
**Responses: total of 1,003 from 767 households** (236 envelopes contained 2 surveys)—**31% response rate!**

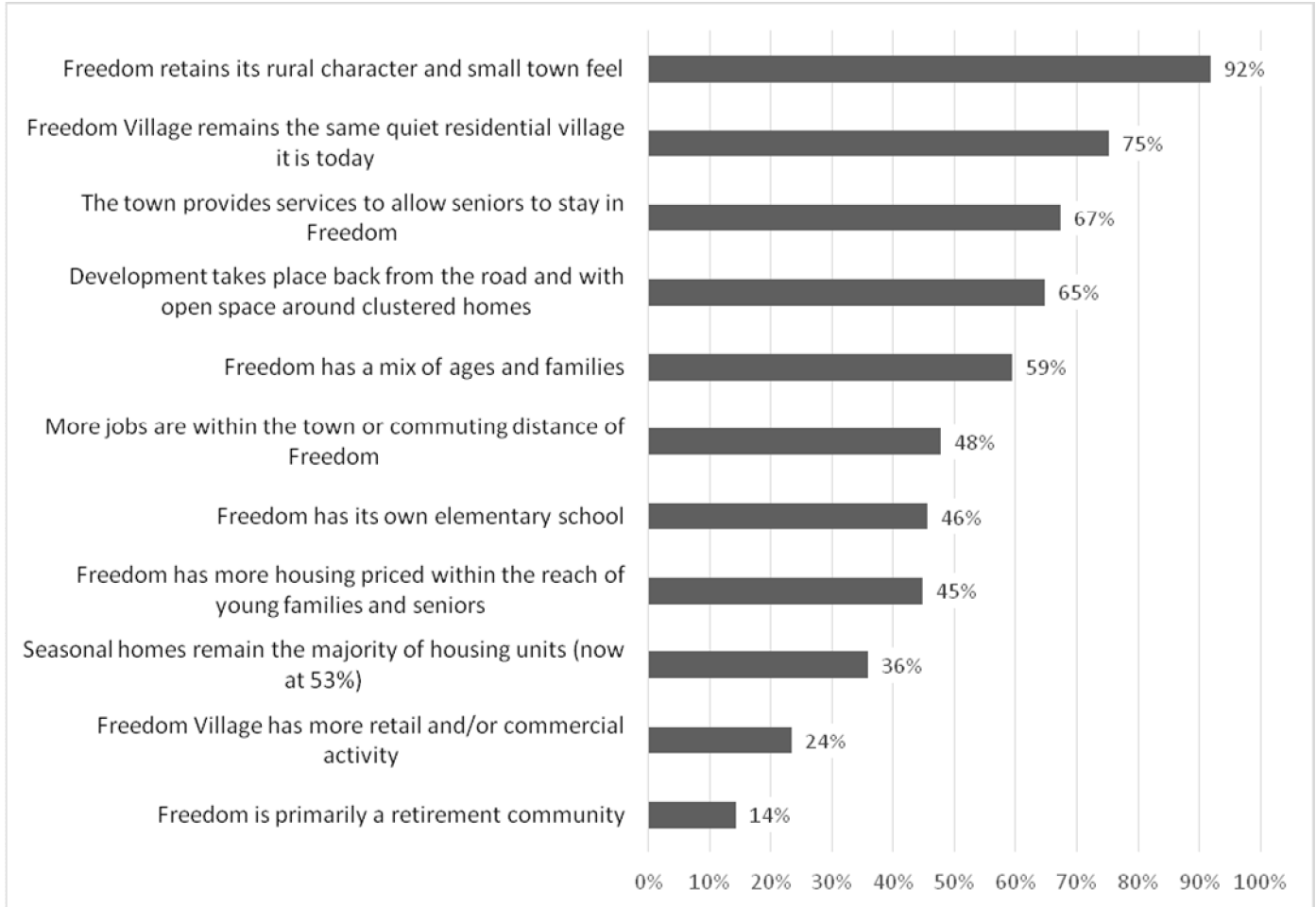


### 1b. Which one of the above do you feel is most important to protect over the next 10 years? (Write in code letter)

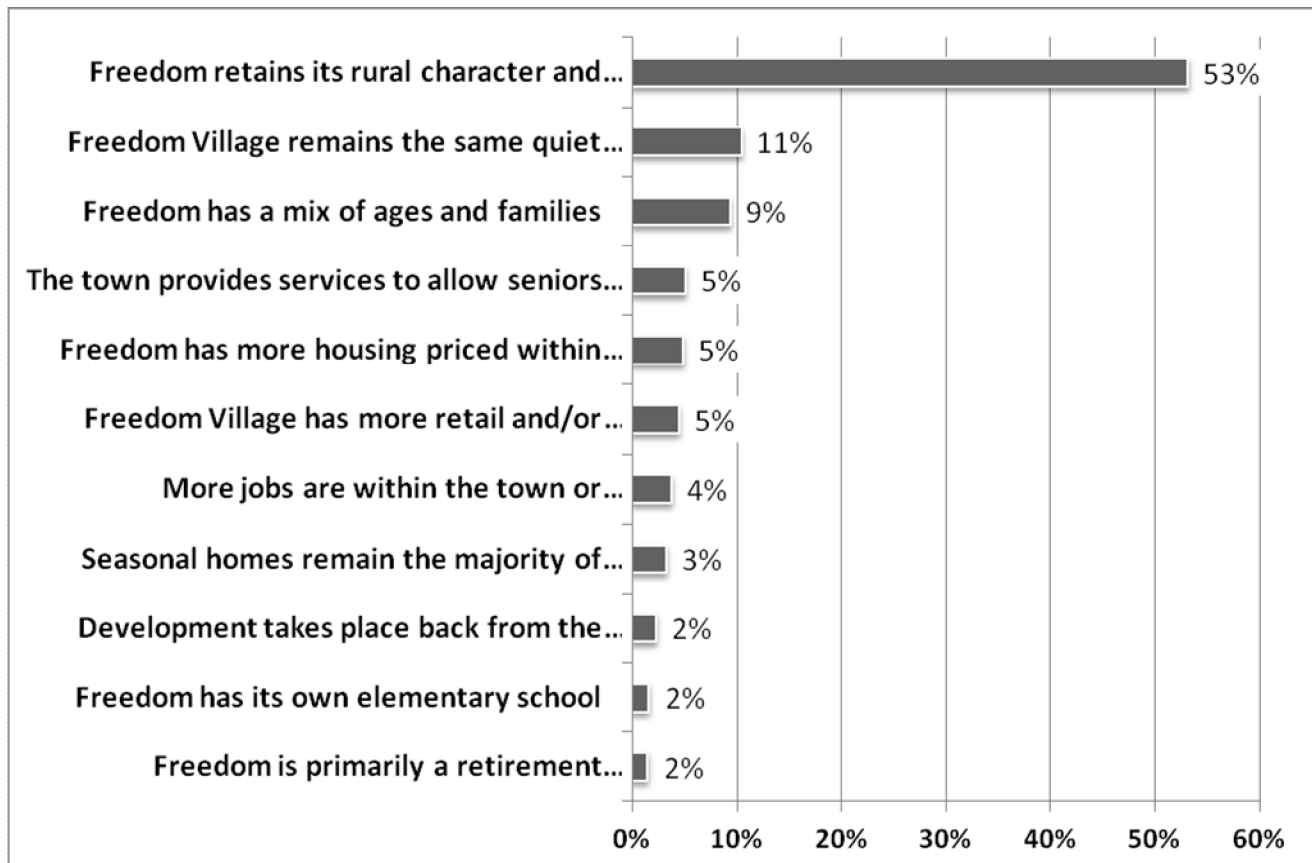


**2a. How important do you feel the following are to your vision of Freedom over the next ten years?**

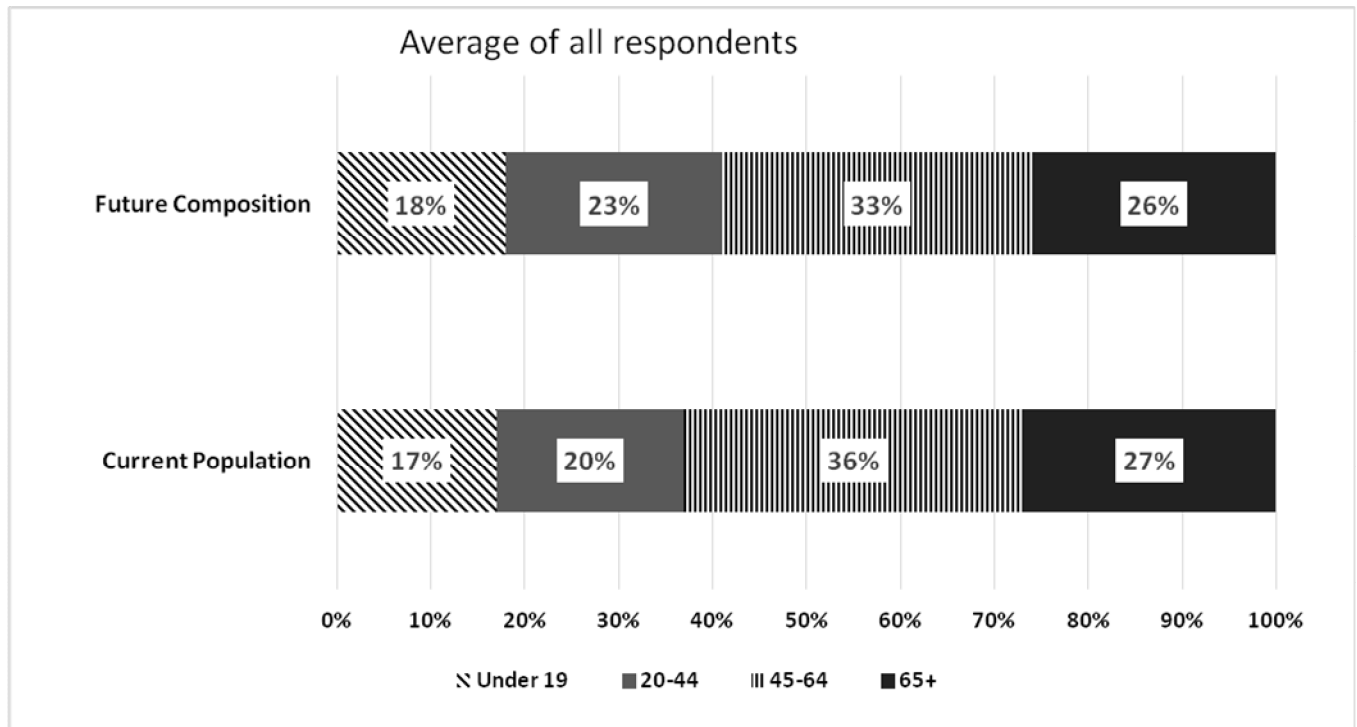
3. In the 2010 census, the age of Freedom's population was:

Under 19 years=17%, 20-44 years=20%, 45-64 years 36%, and 65 years and older=27%.

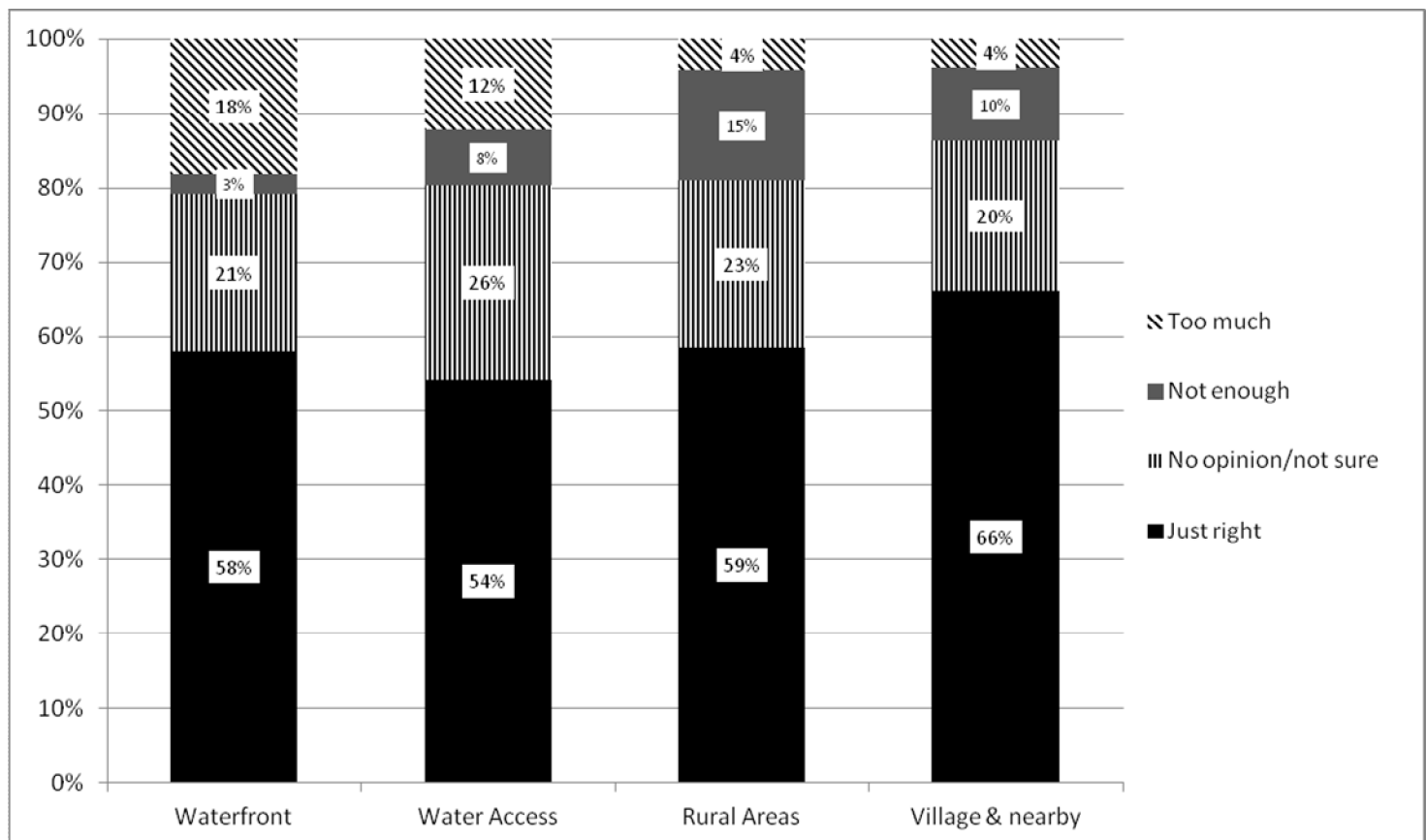
**What would you like the composition of our community to be in 10 years?**

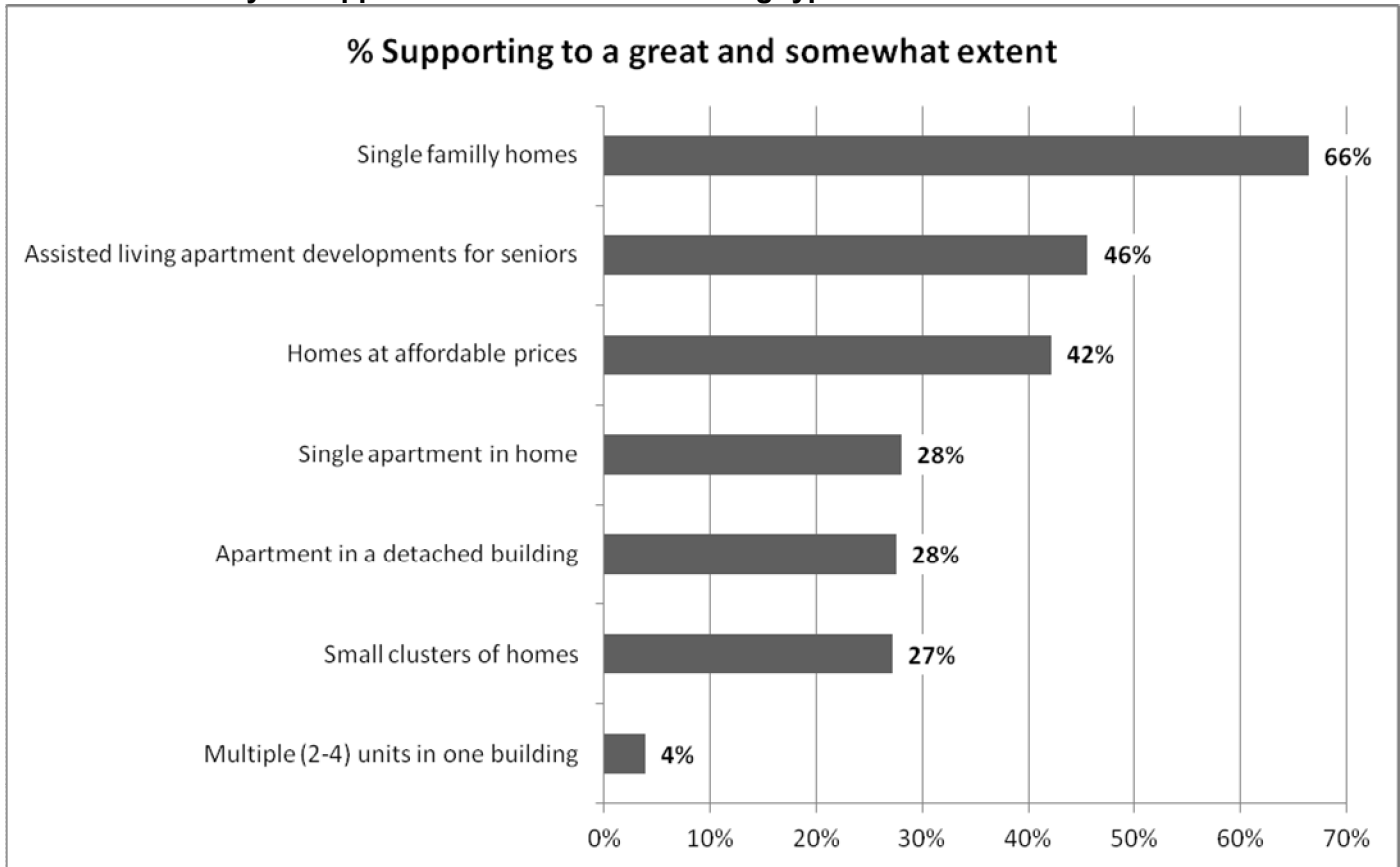

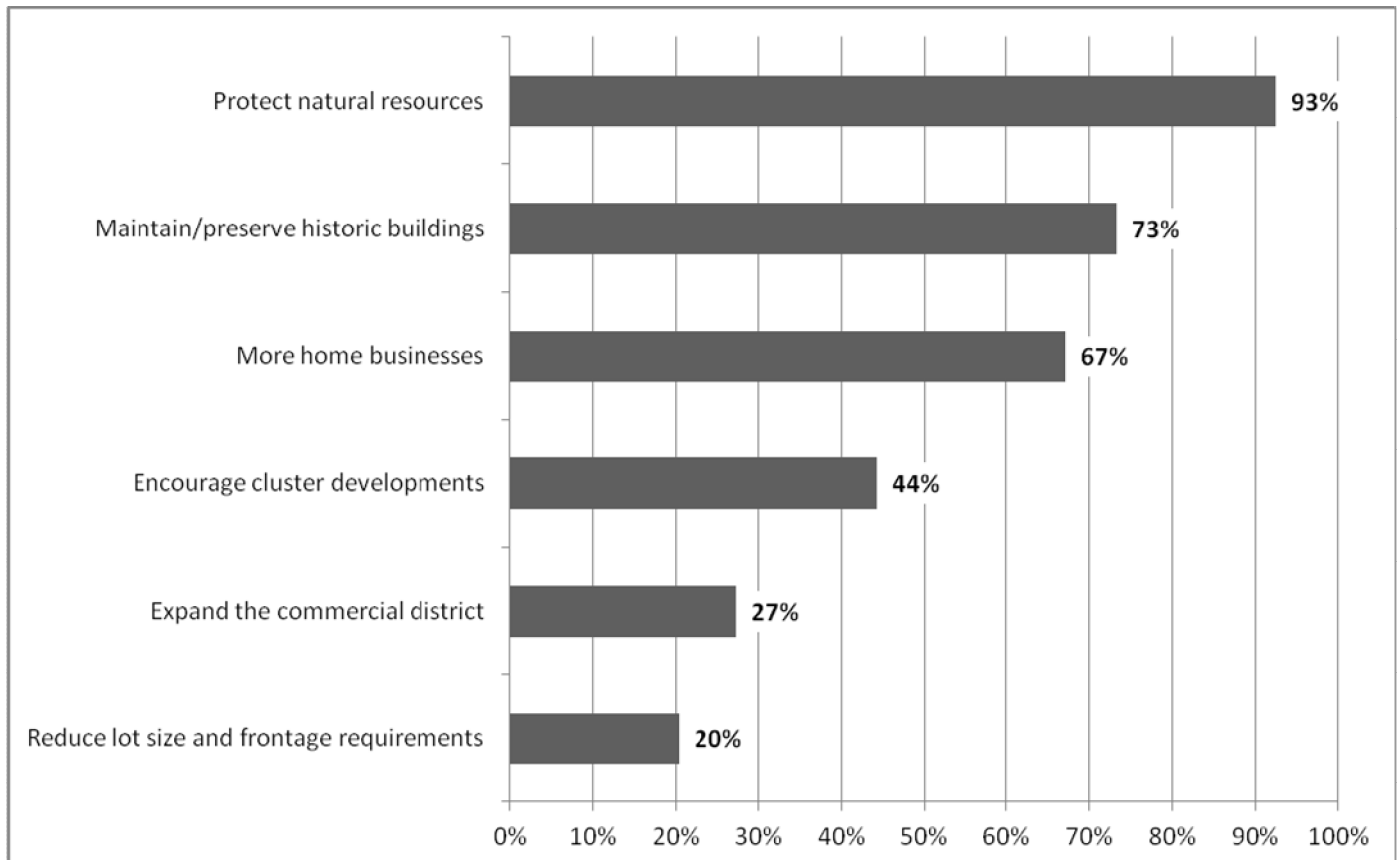
4. How do you feel about the current level of housing development in Freedom?



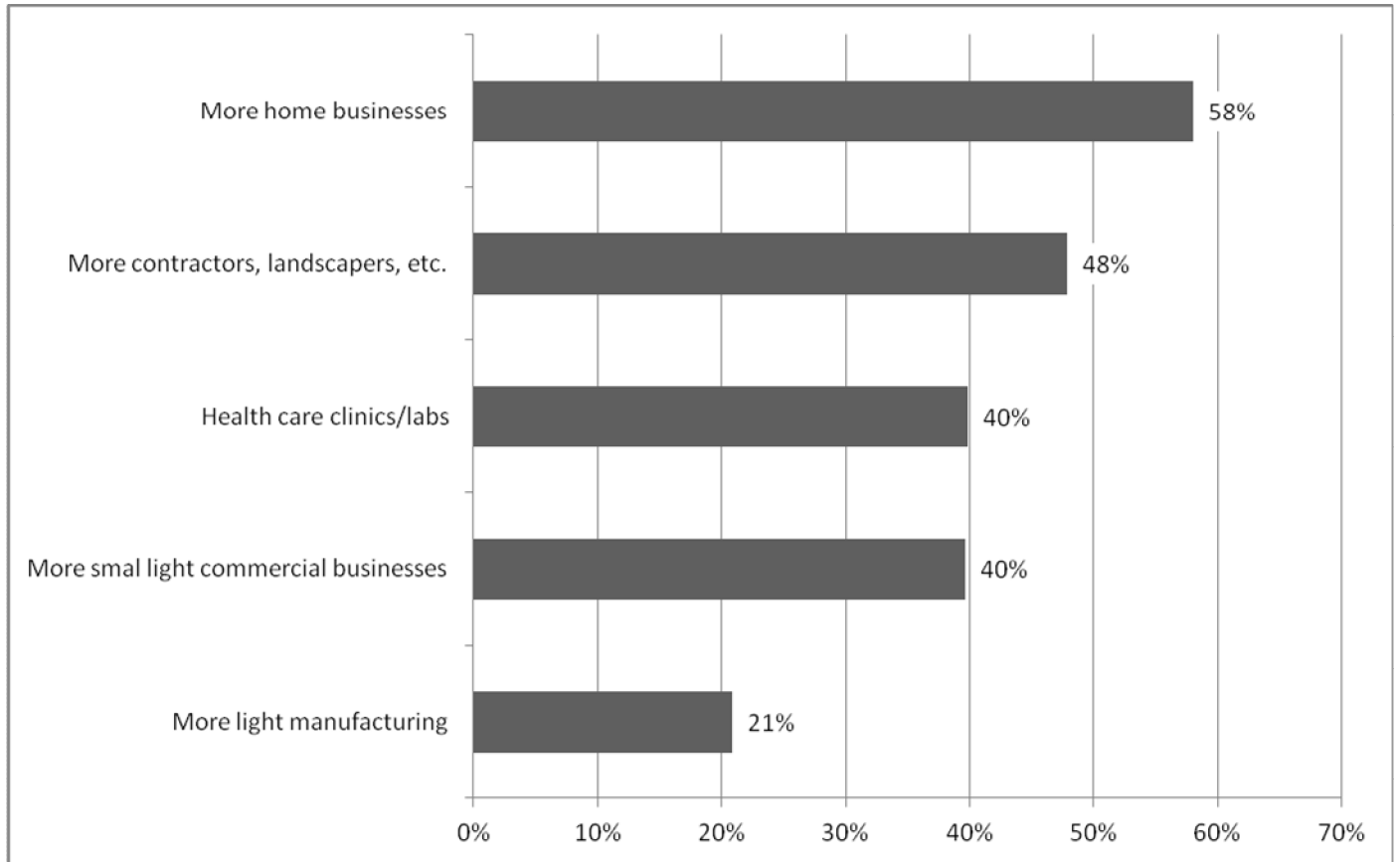
**5. To what extent do you support construction of following types of residences in town?**



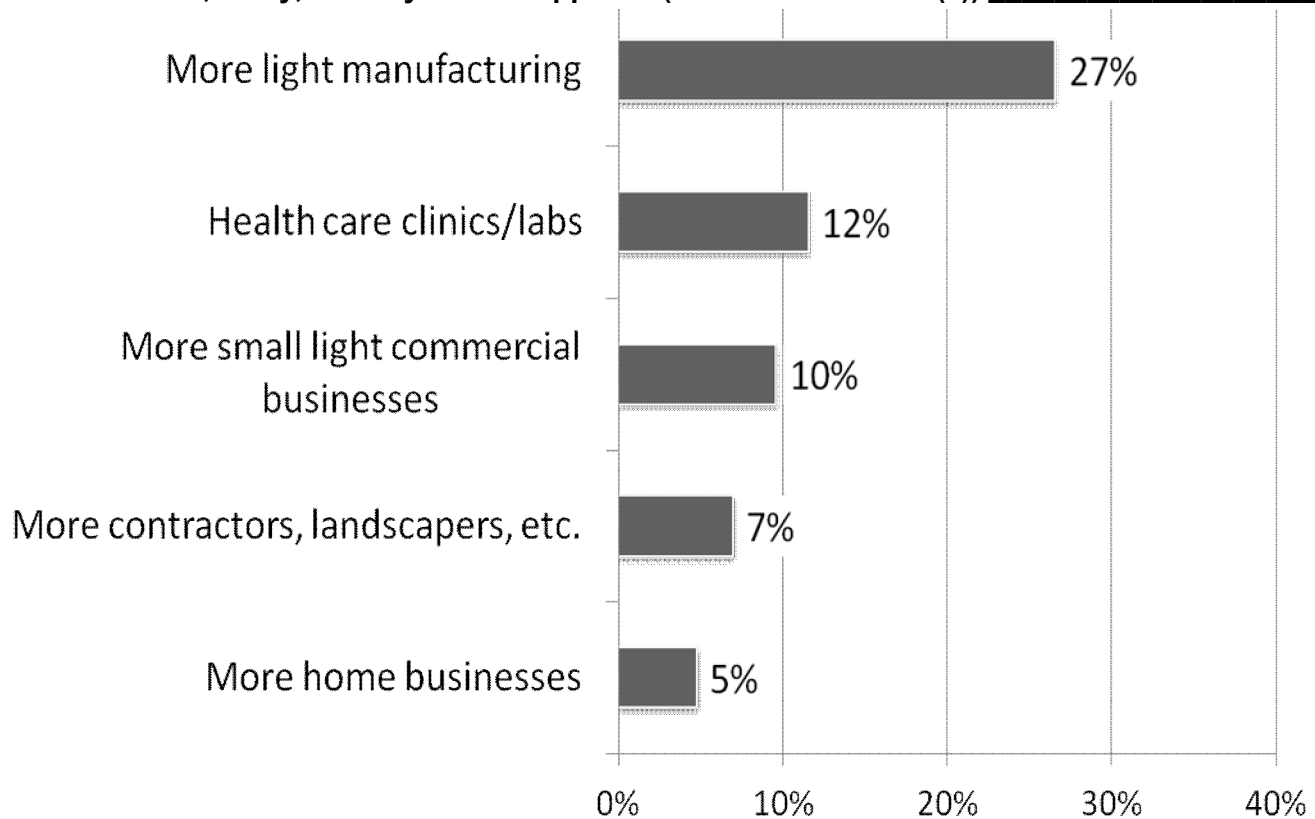
**6. To what extent do you want future zoning regulations to support the following.**

8a. What level of tax support do you want to see used for the following?

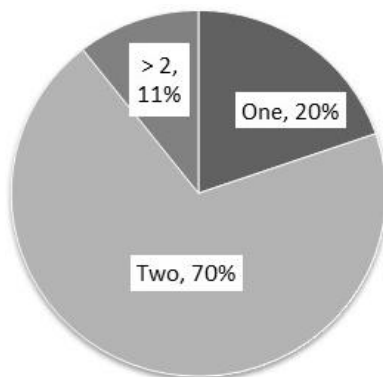
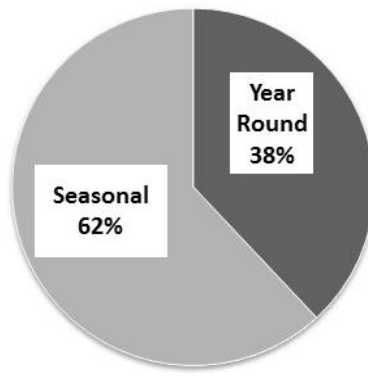
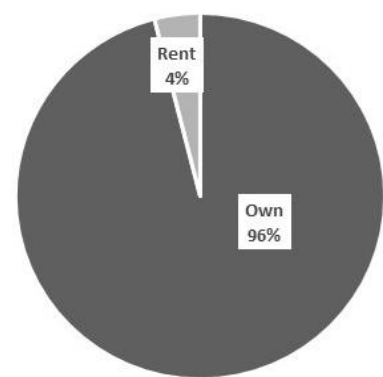
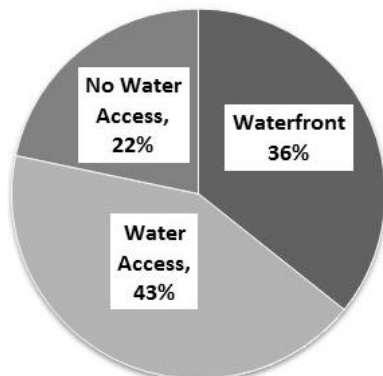
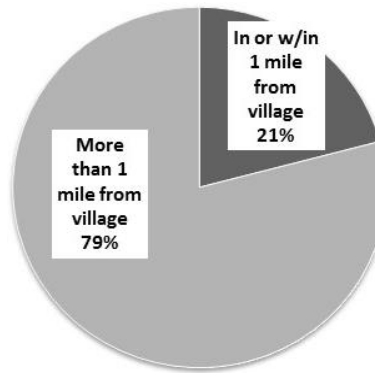
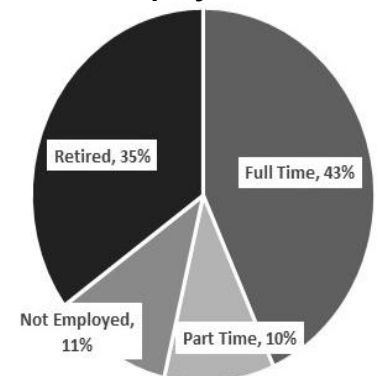
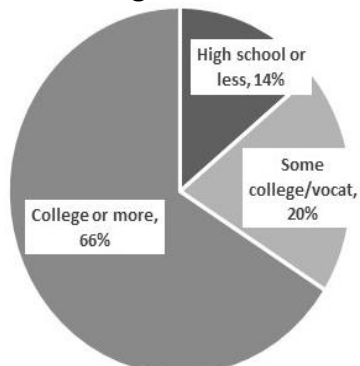
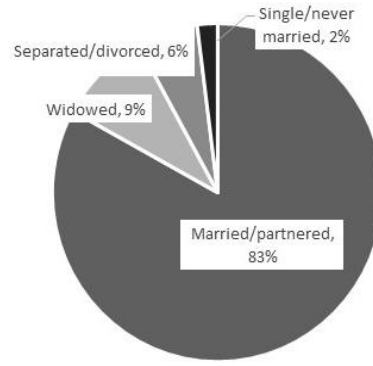


9a. To what extent do you want the town to provide senior services?
