

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, April 11, 2016**

Present: Leslie Babb, Neal Boyle, Ernest Day, Jr. Selectmen; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Road Agent Scott Brooks; and Bill Elliott.

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm, manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Babb reported that the Road Agent had met individually with the Selectmen with the pricing for the plow and dump body systems. They agreed to purchase the systems through Donovan Equipment. Although their bid was \$1500 higher they were getting a much better studier system. Brooks reported that it will be ready in 10 weeks.

Babb asked for public comment and Elliott stated that he had looked at the roller shed and would this still be an option for Old Home Week storage. It was reported that the work on the shed doesn't even start until August. Babb indicated that there could be another option for storage but the board would need to receive a written request first.

Babb asked for department head updates and Brooks stated he had nothing new to report; usual spring cleanup.

Hatch reported that the Road Bond application had been submitted to the Bond Bank that morning. A packet is being put together and is due Friday to Bond Council who will render a decision on if we should receive the bond. The auditors will be in next week the 20 and 21st.

Day reported that he had Jack Pyne had spoken to him. He is moving and will not be able to fulfill his mowing contract.

Boyle shared that it is Fishing Derby time. Wayne Marshall who was a huge contributor to the derby is no longer in town and he is looking at over avenues in which to raise monies and acquire prizes. The derby this year is May 21st.

Babb made a motion to enter non public session at 7:15pm under RSA 91-A:3 II (a) and (c). Returned to open session at 7:58pm and meeting was adjourned.
