

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, July 17, 2017

Present: Ernest Day, Neal Boyle Selectmen; (Babb was absent) Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Patrolman Joe Duchesne, Road Agent Scott Brooks, FCC Chair Paul Elie and Sylvia Carney.

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

The board discussed with Brooks a letter of complaint received regarding runoff onto their property from Abenaki Drive Brooks will try to reach them again.

Day asked for public comment and Elie announced that Conservation Commission has lost 2 members; Greg Bossart has retired as an alternate and member Kyle Johnson has moved out of town.

Elie also commented on the receipt of another invoice from the attorney for work on the Ossipee Lake Protection/Westward Shores.

Chief Shackford did not have his statistical update, however, the department has been very busy. One major issue is with a resident close to Danforth Bay Campground. He is upset by all the smoke generated by the campsites and would like it stopped.

Brooks reported that they are currently replacing culverts on Fife & Drum way; addressing a drainage issue on Haverhill Street and will move onto culvert replacement on Moulton Road.

Due to Babb being out the board agreed to table the zoning application rule change until a future meeting.

Day made a motion to enter non public session at 7:05pm under RSA 91-A:3 II (c).

Returned to open session at 7:14pm and meeting was adjourned.
