

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836  
Monday, April 23, 2018**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Bill Elliott gave the Selectmen written information from Marlin Controls, Inc regarding a radar sign that he received from the Town of Moultonborough, who uses this system.

Patrick Miele stated he has looked back through prior minutes and has been waiting for word from the Selectmen about when the speed signs would go up in the village. Nancy Griffin asked if the group from the state that had visited last fall had approved the use of signs at Cushing Corner Road, Old Portland Road, and Village Road. Les responded that they had.

Petula Plunges showed a picture of a sign that Purity Spring Resort uses on Route 153, a state road, that is highly visible, works all year round and is solar powered. She asked if the Selectmen could look into using this sign.

Chief Josh Shackford reviewed the steps taken by the Police Department last fall in response to the complaints about speeding in the village. Mentioned the town purchasing a radar gun for \$1,000 and have citizens use it discreetly.

A motion was made by Les, seconded by Ernie to have Alan contact the NH DOT at Gilford about the sign.

Mark McKinley reviewed an estimate to replace the outdoor light bulbs at the Public Safety Building. The selectmen would like to look at the plans of the building to see what fixtures and lights would go in if they changed everything to LED.

Josh mentioned Eversource coming to the town of Madison and changing everything over to LED lights. The cost was rolled into the monthly invoices.

There was no public comment.

Per Scott Brooks via phone, the only roads that are still posted are: Scarboro Road, Moulton Road, and Watson Hill Road.

Josh reviewed the week's calls.

Rob Cunio Reviewed EMS and fire calls. They are not issuing brush burning permits at this time. Rob is getting a quote to get the Forestry 1 truck's head bolt and gaskets fixed. He said it could come out of the capital budget..

Motion made by Alan to adjourn, seconded by Ernie. Meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm.
