

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, June 18, 2018**

Present: Leslie R. Babb, Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall, Selectmen; Fire Chief Rob Cunio; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Bill Elliott

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Being no public comment Chief Shackford gave the usual department report which also included several fireworks noise complaints. There was a fire from one incident which both Shackford and Cunio explained the fines and charges that would be forthcoming as we have a fireworks ordinance in place as well.

Shackford indicated that the delivery of the new police truck will be a month later than expected due to a fire at the plant.

Cunio reported they had 7 medical calls with one transport. The State Forest Warden was contacted regarding the fireworks fire and there will be a meeting with him to review the billing to the violator for members and equipment.

Cunio also reported that he is issuing campfire permits but still not for brush piles due to the dryness.

Hatch inquired about voiding a check created in February that was being held to make the last payment of the stewardship plan. No final plan has been received and Hatch believes no one is perusing acquiring it. The board agreed to void the check. Day will speak with Barry Keith about the plan.

The board next reviewed several tax payment agreements that they had with landowners that were now in violation of that agreement. Most will receive letters stating that their property will be taken by tax deed if any taxes prior to 2016 are not paid by August 1st.

Meeting adjourned at 7:41pm.
