MINOR LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT OR BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT

GENERAL PROCEDURE

Submission Requirements

- Completed application and payment of fee
- A site location map showing the original boundaries of the adjacent parcels
- 4 paper copies and a mylar (appropriate for filing at the Carroll County Registry of Deeds) of a detailed plat (24" by 36") showing the new property lines, bearings, distances and all new permanent corner markers, area of two new created lots shall be indicated in acreage and square feet, as a result of the minor lot line adjustment/boundary agreement signed by a NH licensed surveyor.
- An 11" by 17" electronic version of the detailed plat submitted via email to office@townoffreedom.net

Fee Schedule: Commercial Properties: \$100.00 Filing Fee. In addition, the applicant is responsible for:

- The applicant pays \$8.00 per abutter to be submitted with the application and,
- The applicant shall submit a check in the amount of \$25.00 payable to the "Carroll County Registry of Deeds" pursuant to RSA 478:17-g II. This state fee is for funding L-CHIP.

Residential Properties: \$75.00 Filing Fee. In addition, the applicant is responsible for:

- The applicant pays \$8.00 per abutter to be submitted with the application and,
- The applicant shall submit a check in the amount of \$25.00 payable to the "Carroll County Registry of Deeds" pursuant to RSA 478:17-g II. This state fee is for funding L-CHIP.

The accepted and signed Plat shall be filed in the Carroll County Registry of Deeds and a copy with the Freedom Planning Board with the following statement:

"This plan shows the Minor Lot Line Adjustment/Boundary Agreement and does not require the approval of the Freedom Planning Board as a subdivision."

Procedure and Notice

- This application shall conform in all respects to the Subdivision Regulations of the Town of Freedom
- The board shall review the application and determine if the proposal is a Minor Lot Line Adjustment or Boundary Agreement.
- Notice is required to abutters, the applicant, and any signers of the plat.
- Any abutter shall be heard on the application for review at the public hearing. If deemed necessary, the Board may adjourn its consideration to another date and time to allow further abutter participation.
