

Minutes of Special Heritage Commission Meeting Wednesday, July 11, 2018 10:30am FVS

A quorum being established, the meeting called to order at 10:30 am.

Agenda items:

Peg explained that the special meeting was necessary to approve by formal vote possible expense for a framed poster to recognize the Roller Shed preservation project.

Discussion followed Peg's announcement that a Preservation Alliance representative, possibly Andrew Cushing, will attend the Old Home Week Ice Cream Social on August 9th in the evening. It was decided that 2 enlarged posters, 16 x 20 inches, replications of the poster Peg put together of photos and explanation of the Roller Barn preservation project, properly framed under glass or plexiglass, would be purchased with a view to hanging one in Town Hall and one with suitable weather proofing to be hung on the outside of the Roller Barn itself. The Commission members voted to do this at a cost not to exceed \$400 from the Commission budget. In addition, 3 enlargement copies, 8 ½ x 11 inches, will be made to offer to the Historical Society, to put in our Inventory notebook along with other material on the Roller Barn, and to possibly put in the HC binder at the town Library. It was agreed that we can make such copies ourselves. Peg said Walmart can make such enlargements for the two to be framed. Michael's also might be considered for the framing and glass if they offer attractive discounts. Sometime during the Ice Cream Social, Bill Elliott as Master of Ceremony will be asked to introduce the representative from the Preservation Alliance who will make a brief commendation to the Heritage Commission, represented by Peg, and the Town for the award won for this preservation project of a rare historic structure. Our Roller Barn is one of only three original storage sheds for snow rollers left in the state of New Hampshire. Peg will present the framed enlargement of the poster to the Town and the weatherproofed copy will be hung on the outside of the Barn.

Bonnie will incorporate photos Peg will send her into the brief text Gale will write for publicity in the Conway Sun for this event. Bonnie will send this pr to the appropriate staff member at the Sun and suggest that their local reporter might like to be present to cover the event on 8/9/18.

Scott will continue to research possibilities of getting a snow roller. Bob Smart announced that his neighbor Jane Nylander will give a presentation during OHW on the history of parade floats in New Hampshire. The Historical Society will sponsor this program based on work Jane has done for her new book.

The special meeting was adjourned at 10:51 am (21 minutes volunteer time). Next meeting is September 13, 2018 at the Church, 6 pm.
