

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, October 15, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Advisory Committee on Aging Chair Rick Davidson presented a summary of their research. The largest hurdles are the ability to communicate available services to people in town that may not use a computer, transportation for appointments etc. They would like to bring a petitioned warrant article to the town requesting funds for expanding services. Per the Selectmen's request, the Committee will put together a specific proposal and estimate of costs and will meet again with the board when it is complete.

Sandy Boyle explained what the 211 system is and what it does. There are brochures in the lobby of the Town Office.

Chief Shackford gave his report which included 2 suicide threat calls, deer and bear encounters with automobiles, litter complaints and alarm calls. He attended the Police Chief's meeting and reported there is a new drug rehabilitation center in Conway for opiate addiction. This center accepts Medicare and Medicaid.

Transfer Station Manager Justin Brooks has a quote for a new trash compactor.

Road Agent Scott Brooks reported that the furnace and the pump at the town garage are both gone. He would like to use the higher bid for a commercial furnace which is about \$9,000. He will get two more bids and present those to the Selectmen.

Les asked if the other two Selectmen had any issue with the audit. They did not, so Les signed off on it.

There being no other business, Les made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Alan. Meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm.
