

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836  
Monday, May 13, 2019**

Present: Leslie R. Babb, Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall, Selectmen; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.

Meeting was called to order at 6:15pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Meeting adjourned at 6:30pm to move to Town Hall for the remainder of the agenda.

Meeting reconvened at 6:36pm. Present were Leslie R. Babb, Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall, Selectmen; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Fire Chief Rob Cunio; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Road Agent Scott Brooks; Eaton Selectmen Ed Riley and Dick Fortin; Effingham Selectman Mike Cahalane; Ossipee Corner Fire Chief Riley; Eric Damon of CarePlus Ambulance; Todd Desmarais and Bill Elliott.

The board did a quick review of the State D.O.T. approval of the final plans for the Danforth Bay Bridge application. Still waiting on approval from D.R.E.D.

The board met with Ann Babb the Tax Collector to review those with current property tax agreements. The board agreed that all those that have not kept up payments should be on the tax deed list for taking.

Next reviewed was the Ossipee Lake Village paving – the Road Agent reported that All States will hold their price on the bid received last week. Fall made a motion to award the bid to All States Asphalt; Day seconded, voted yes unanimously.

Being no public comment the Road Agent reported that road stripping had been done that day. They are preparing roads for dust control Thursday and the following Thursday.

Chief Cunio gave his update. He did state that he and several members will be attending the wake and funeral of a former member who was serving as Assistant Fire Chief in Center Conway. Center Ossipee will be staffed and covering our station during those times. The annual fishing derby will be this Sunday at the mill pond.

Chief Shackford reported some of the usual calls, a horse dispute and an assist in Effingham for a domestic.

The board discussed with Damon the end dates of the current ambulance contract. There was uncertainty and confusion. Damon stated that they are willing and prepared to honor the contract thru 2021. This will be brought up at next week's official regional meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 7:20pm.
