Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836 Monday, December 16, 2013

Present: Neal Boyle, Ernest Day, Jr., Selectmen; Road Agent Scott Brooks; Karen Hatch, Town Administrator and several citizens. Selectman Babb was absent.

Meeting opened at 6:30pm. Manifests were signed and general mail was reviewed.

Boyle asked Brooks about when the final asphalt coat is applied on the new culvert near Camp Calumet; could it be made into a speed bump. Brooks explained that due to the road being considered a rural connector a speed bump would not be allowed.

There was discussion on the investment policy, Hatch explained that this was an annual requirement but it has not been done for several years due to the board not agreeing on how the monies should be invested. Day made a motion to table until next week when Babb was available; seconded by Boyle.

Boyle asked for public comment and Bill Elliott inquired about taxing more than once a year. Day indicated that this is already on the January 6^{th} agenda.

Babb had called in earlier in the day and reported that he had spoken with Brett Buggeln at Tarpan Towers about the logs and debris still on the site near the road. He stated he will try and have logs cleaned from the site by the end of the week.

There was no new information on the town of equipment being on the tower.

Motion was made at 7:16pm to enter non public under RSA 91-A:3 II(c); they then would be in non public under RSA 91-A:3 II(a) for employee reviews.

Returned to open session and meeting was adjourned at 7:36pm.

The board agreed not to do employee reviews until next week when Babb would be present.
