## Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836 Monday, March 10, 2014

Present: Neal Boyle, Leslie Babb, Ernest Day, Jr., Selectmen; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Karen Hatch, Town Administrator, and several citizens.

Meeting opened at 6:00pm. Manifests were signed and general mail was reviewed.

The board appointed John Roman from an alternate to a full member of the Conservation Commission for a three year term.

Boyle asked for public comment and Paul Olzerowicz announced that he would be running as a write in for Trustee of Trust Funds.

Carol Demore announced that at any future town board meetings she would be attending she would be video and/or audio taping. Boyle explained that she just needed to announce that at the beginning of the meeting so that all present were aware.

Babb brought up for discussion one of the proposed zoning amendments with Demore and her mother Ellie Stokes. This amendment affects the zone where the Stokes home is on Route 153. This amendment is on the ballot to be voted on Town Meeting Day.

Road Agent Brooks reviewed his proposed budget with the board. He stated that an error had been made in the full time payroll and should be lower by \$6,600.00. He also would like to amend his budget at town meeting to add an additional \$17,400.00. With this amount and the payroll error this would cover the additional salt, sand and equipment rental he projects would be needed for the remainder of this winter and the start of next winter. The board was in agreement to have the article amended.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:54pm to attend the Annual School District Meeting.
