

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, May 19, 2014**

Meeting opened at 6:30pm. Manifests were signed and general mail was reviewed.

Babb brought up the agenda item regarding the vote on Jackman Ridge Road. Babb stated he re-read the Forest Stewardship Plan. Babb made a motion, seconded by Day to rescind the vote from the May 12th, 2014 meeting and send the Jackman Ridge Road bid to the Freedom Conservation Commission for review. All were in favor.

Public Comment:

Michael Gaudette, FCC Chairman, noted that there will be a cut at the Town Forest and the trucks could do damage to any repairs made to the Jackman Ridge Road. Gaudette will address at the FCC meeting on the 20th.

Justin Brooks stated that the emergency cellular site off the cell tower is working. The portable and truck radios have been tested. There is great service out to the state line now.

Scott Brooks reported that the road crew has been working in the hills continuing to clean ditches and doing grade work.

Bill Elliott informed all that the Community Club will be doing their annual road clean up on the 20th. They plan to do the same roads as in years past.

Boyle listed the winners of the annual fishing derby on May 17th. The Under 10 winner was Gage Libby. The winner of 10-15 was Devin Nelson.
