

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, September 22, 2014

Present: Leslie Babb, Neal Boyle, Ernest Day, Jr., Selectmen; Karen Hatch Town Adm.; Peg Scully and Scott Cunningham.

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm, manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

The board signed the request for proposal for the regional ambulance contract. A submission deadline was discussed and the board agreed that they would be fine with whatever date the other towns agreed on.

The board also signed the release of the letter of credit for Tarpon Towers as voted last week.

Babb asked for department head updates and Hatch inquired on behalf of the Freedom Food Pantry if they needed to submit a petition for funding this year. The board will include this in the welfare budget and no petition will be necessary.

There was a brief discussion on the recording of the North Broad Bay Road that was being done by Hambrook Surveying; Hatch will contact Hambrook on this matter.

Babb next asked for public comment ó Peg Scully reported that she has picked up the new Welcome to Freedom sign and submitted the invoice. She stated that the sign came out nice and was of a material that would last for many years.

Scott Cunningham inquired about the paving of Cushing Corner Road and was there going to be an obligation to take over the road when complete, Babb indicated no, there had not been any communication regarding this with the state.

Hatch inquired about the advertising for the sale of 205 West Bay Road. Dates were agreed on. Bids will be due to purchase this property Monday, October 6th.

Boyle mentioned changing the weekday at the transfer station to Wednesday. It was agreed to stay with Tuesday.

Babb made a motion to enter non public session at 7:19pm. Returned to open session at 7:45pm.

Hatch indicated that several residents had been in doing research that live on winter maintained roads; looking at possibly having them accepted as town roads. Hatch asked what criteria the board looked at when presented with this request. Babb indicated a few of the items that were looked at, this included - was it a through road; was the road originally built to town specifications, was there an adequate right of way for the maintenance of drainage etc.; was the road used by the school bus and the population density.

Meeting adjourned at 7:58pm.
