ZBA Case #32-33-14 Wittrock Revocable Trust ó Applicant seeks an appeal for a special exception under Article 3 Section 304.6.5.3 and a variance under Article 4 Section 406 of the zoning ordinance: To replace a failed septic within 125øof wetlands and tree cutting in the shorefront district at 37 East Danforth Rd.

FCC Concerns:

- FCC would like tree point system addressed
- FCC would like to see point system
- What are the plans for root and stump removal?
- Safe erosion control practices must be adhered to
- Consider putting leach field on other side of house thereby increasing the distance from water

Case #23-57-4-14 Elise Pydynkowski-Applicant seeks an appeal for a variance under Article 3 Section 310.1.5 of the zoning ordinance: To build house, garage, shed and porous porch covering more than 10% of the lot on Deer Run Rd.

- No information given for this application.

Case #21-1-1-14 Camp Cody-Applicant seeks appeal for Special Exception from Article 3 Section 304.6.3.1 and 304.6.5.2 of the zoning ordinance: To permit the relocation of 5 cabins, #8-12, from within 30\phi-50\phi\off the shoreline to a distance greater than 200\phi\off from the shoreline.

FCC Concerns:

- Use Best Management Practices for Erosion Control
- Board agrees with the tree cutting but stumps and roots must stay intact
- Alternate plan to retain 24ö oak tree between cabin #10 and 11

Tax Map #16, Lot #9

Rob passed out maps of this location stating it had just been acquired by the town and is going up for public auction. The board agreed to submit a recommendation to the Bos stating:

If the Town of Freedom takes large parcels of land the Freedom Conservation Commission would like the Board of Selectmen to consider restricting the deed for no subdivision and or consider it for conservation purposes. All were in favor.

Other Business

Bill brought up the subject, to the FAC, of a hike to Maryøs Mountain or Trout Pond during Old Home Week as well as wagon ride through town forest. The Freedom Old Home Week Committee would like to keep the hikeøs but cancel the wagon ride until next year as itøs the 10th anniversary of the Town Forest.

Public Comment

Susan Marks commented on the plans for approved septic systems on the lake stating the board should be in touch with Green Mountain Conservation Group as well as Freedom Planning Board.
