

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, March 21, 2016**

Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm, manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Brooks asked Selectmen to authorize him to sign contract to purchase culvert for Square Brook. Babb made a motion, Day seconded, Voted 3-0 in favor.

Mark McKinley said he will have 3 proposals for the March 28 selectmen's meeting regarding work to the Roller Shed. Babb started the process of a major purchase using mid level purchasing procedures. Submission deadline for submitting proposals for this work will be April 4, 2016

Selectmen reviewed proposals for the cleanup of property located at 50 Eaton Road. One of the contractors will be contacted to find out if they are insured. If they are not, Selectmen will seek a guarantee from the other contractor that invoice will not exceed the quote. Review will be continued at the next meeting.

Police Chief Shackford said there had been a great response for a lost hiker call in the town forest. He mentioned that the new cruiser should be here either in mid May or Mid July.

Babb announced that Brooks will be looking for a Ford dump truck under fleet pricing. If he cannot find one, he will get bids on a Dodge truck from Crest, Lee or Berlin City.

Babb made a motion to enter into non public session at 7:25pm under RSA 91-A:3 II(a) and returned to open session at 7:30pm and meeting was adjourned.
