

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, January 22, 2018

Present: Leslie R. Babb, Neal E. Boyle, Ernest F. Day, Jr., Selectmen; Fire Chief Justin Brooks; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; John Shipman and Bill Elliott.

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Babb made a motion at 7:00pm to enter non public session under RSA 91-A:3 II(c).
Returned to open session at 7:05pm.

Babb asked for public comment and Shipman asked for an update where the board was with the scanning of tax documents. The other option discussed was a vault which many towns have. Shipman is an advocate on either as long as the documents are preserved and secure. Day will speak with the Heritage Commission on this.

Chief Brooks reported that engine 7 should be back from repairs tomorrow. The fishing derby was a success with 170 registrants.

Chief Shackford had the final cost of lettering the new cruiser.

Hatch stated that a new website tab had been recreated for volunteers. Babb then gave the background on how this originated with the resigning of an alternate on Planning Board. There were two request for appointment forms, one being generic and the other was specific for the Conservation Commission. The board agreed to have both on the website.

The board worked on the budget and discussed Capital Reserve Funds and projected uses.
