

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836**  
**Monday, November 19, 2018**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Public Comment: Bill Elliott wanted to thank the Police Department for their presence on Halloween. They were very helpful to people and children on the street that night.

Department Heads: Rob Cunio gave his report regarding calls for the last week. Chief Shackford also gave his weekly report. Bill Elliott asked how the town carries Narcan. Rob Cunio explained that Narcan is carried by rescue. Justin said that all the machines at the Transfer Station have been serviced and ready for the winter. The windstorm last week blew a tree down and damaged about 20 feet of the perimeter fence. He has put this item into his budget for replacement. The contract with Casella Waste ends at the end of 2019 and he is expecting significant increases when that contract ends.

Ernie opened two sealed bids for the truck. The ad in the Conway Sun and notices read as follows: *The Town of Freedom is receiving sealed bids on a F550 Ford 4x4 with plow frame only. The truck a Power Stroke Diesel, 5 speed Manual Transmission, and 19.5 Wheels. The sander is a stainless steel Highway Super P, 3cy sander with pony motor. Sander has all new bearing and clutch 3 years ago. New pony motor last winter. Bids will be due November 19, 2018 at noon with the bid opening that evening at 7pm. There was a bid from Darwin Moulton for \$5,199, and a bid from Les Babb for \$3,800. Ernie made a motion, seconded by Alan to accept Darwin Moulton's bid.

Carol Stansell, a Supervisor of the Checklist requested a nonpublic meeting under **RSA 91-A:3II(c)** regarding the issue of wireless connection and printers. It was explained to her that the person being named has the right to request the meeting be held publicly. Carol withdrew her request.

The supervisors have been given a laser printer that is currently being kept in the Building Inspector's office. This printer will be locked up at the Town Hall. Carol said this will give them what they need for security.

There being no further business before the board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ernie, seconded by Alan. Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm.
