

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836  
Monday, November 26, 2018**

Present: Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall, Les Babb, Selectmen, Fire Chief Rob Cunio, Administrative Assistant Janice Zecher, Bill Elliott, Anne Cunningham.

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Public Comment: None

Department Heads: Rob Cunio gave his report regarding calls for the last week. He said they are at 339 medical and fire calls for the year to date. LED flashing lights have been ordered and will be installed on trucks. Les mentioned that he thinks the Police Department and Fire Department should buy a shared drone for searches. Rob agreed, Rob will research and report his findings. Also discussed was researching regulations for flying drones for police and fire vs. the general public.

Janice Zecher, Administrative Assisted asked the board to reconsider allowing payment plans for campers at Danforth Bay for delinquent taxes. Assessing and taxing of Danforth Bay is very complicated and the addition of payment plans would further complicate efforts to keep ownership of campers straight. The board agreed unanimously that payment plans for campgrounds would no longer be offered. There are currently 2 agreements in place.

Ernie reviewed the Fire Department and Transfer Station's budget with Les because he wasn't at the meeting the previous week. The fire department would like to re-encumber \$5,000 to work on the fire pond for Jerry Brooks and \$1,000 for dry hydrants. Les would like to research to get the correct process.

Anne Cunningham presented the budget for the Planning Board. The Planning Board voted unanimously to ask the Selectmen to encumber \$1,914.08. Motion made by Alan to approve, seconded by Ernie. Les also in favor.

Motion was made by Les, seconded by Ernie to enter into a non-public meeting at 7:40 pm under RSA 91-A:3 II(d). Public meeting resumed at 7:50 pm. Motion made by Les, seconded by Ernie Roll call vote was taken. Leslie Babb ó Yes, Ernest Day, Jr. ó Yes, Alan Fall ó Yes to not publicly disclose the minutes because it is determined that divulgence of the information likely would render the proposed action ineffective. Minutes are sealed until real estate transaction is closed for a period of 2 years.

There being no further business before the board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ernie, seconded by Alan. Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
