**MINUTES OF THE 04/13/2010 Meeting** as recorded on draft dated 06/08/10 were accepted as presented.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

##### **Inventory Sub-Committee:**

- No new reports ready for distribution
- New list of reports to be worked on with notes from the April meeting was distributed. Bob will add locations included in the 2009 Annual Report.
- Bonnie continuing to research present post office. Will contact Pete Nichols for details.
- Research on others locations is continuing.

**Grant Sub - Committee:** No activity to report.

- 1. Visit to Registry of Deeds office in Ossipee:** On May 27<sup>th</sup>. Alan conducted an excellent tour for Raymond, Alice, & Bob. Alan will conduct additional tours for Commission members. Best if group is 4 or fewer individuals.
- 2. Item for Crossroads Publication:** Draft provided by Bob was approved and with addition of óTown Squareö inventory report will be delivered to the publication office.
- 3. Welcome To Freedom Publication:** Bob will prepare a listing for the new publication by selecting information from the Crossroads article and list of Commission members.
- 4. Place Freedom Buildings on Registry of Historical Places:** After discussing action for Town Hall and the present Town Office building it was agreed that more information is needed on how such a designation could affect future repair, use, and modification of these structures. Motion made and approved to move forward with investigation and draft of application to place these buildings on the State Register of Historical places. Peg, Lee Fritz, and Gale Morris will work on the individual Inventory Forms of the Town Offices and Town Hall and present a draft to the HC at the Sept. meeting for their review. The Commission will then determine if they have a proposal for the Select Board.
- 5. Markers at Location of destroyed buildings:** Commission will continue to think about Alan's proposal to place a marker at the sight of buildings that are no longer at that location.
- 6. Community Club Presentation:** Presentation scheduled for 10/13/10 and will consist of 2-3 new inventory reports. Alan will do the presentation. Bob proposed Alan also do a program on öGranting of New Hampshireö similar to the comments he made at the Registry of Deeds visit. Carol proposed this be a program for the Historical Society.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Bob received call from Lee Fritz asking that a motion be approved to allow her neighbors on Watson Hill Rd. to research and draft Inventory Reports on their property. The Commission agreed that no such motion is required, as we have gone on record encouraging such activity.
2. **OHW Tour:** Carol Foord asked Alan to be present and assist with the tour of the Village that she will conduct during OHW.
