

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, February 25, 2019

Present: Leslie R. Babb, Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall, Selectmen; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Fire Chief Rob Cunio; Police Chief Josh Shackford and Transfer Station Manager Justin Brooks.

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

Board reviewed warrant articles and assigned for town meeting day.

Moderator Don Johnson met with the board to review town meeting on March 12th. This included the elections and the warrant.

Cindy Fleming vice Chair of the Committee on Aging along with members Anne Cunningham and Cheryl Harris met with the board to review what their charge or roll would be going forward. They are willing to stay a committee to work more on regional issues, to screen a potential candidate if the warrant article passes for a senior coordinator and to assist and share with them all the resources that they have compiled. The board agreed that they would like them to continue as a committee as a resource for the town.

Being no public comment Chief Shackford gave his update. He had attended a Chief's meeting where they learned about the REAP program for people over 60. This is a Referral, Education, Assistance and Prevention Program through the Department of Health and Human Services. He handed out pamphlets to the board. He also reported on calls they had handled which included an untimely death and an assist in Madison with a homicide.

Chief Cunio gave his report which included 8 medical calls with 3 transports. The winter carnival that they covered at the Town Forest went well. There had been a machine fire on a trail but that was taken care of. He also gave a brief update on the work being done to the Forestry 2 truck.

Brooks stated that he had been a bit busier due to it being school vacation week for Maine and Massachusetts. He is waiting for snow to melt to get to some projects on site.

The board reviewed the draft wording of the public notice for the sale of the Danforth Bay beach lot. Fall to speak with the town attorney on this.
