

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836  
Monday, June 24, 2019**

Present: Ernest F. Day, Jr., Alan G. Fall Selectmen; Leslie Babb was absent. Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Fire Chief Rob Cunio; Police Chief Josh Shackford; Road Agent Scott Brooks; and Transfer Station Manager Justin Brooks.

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm manifests were signed and mail was reviewed.

The Road Agent reported that they should be finished the crack seal tomorrow and paving would be Thursday and Friday depending on rain. He indicated which roads in Ossipee Lake Village would be paved and which would have rubberized chip seal. There would be no treatment at this time on Flintlock Lane and East Danforth Road.

For future consideration would be the reclaiming of Swett Hill Road where work had left off. A response had been received from DRA regarding the moving of encumbered funds from crack sealing to paving. There was not a direct answer and the Selectmen would like a yes/no; Hatch will follow up on this.

The board next met with Mark McKinley. He indicated that the bleachers at the ballfield were in need of replacement or a rebuild. The Little League had brought this to his attention and he has made some repairs and will make more as needed. The board agreed as they are iconic, they should be rebuilt and the same size. Money will be put in the 2020 budget for this.

There was no public comment.

J. Brooks reported that the Transfer Station will be closed for the installation of the new compactor on July 10, 11 and 12<sup>th</sup>. This will be published in the paper and on the website. On Wednesday they will begin removing the metal.

S. Brooks also asked that an ad be in the paper regarding one lane closure of Durgin Hill Road beginning July 8<sup>th</sup> for the work on the underdrain.

Chief Shackford indicated he had visited all the children's camps with the exception of Calumet which was scheduled for this week. There were several calls on cats, alarms and fire works on the air strip in the town forest.

Chief Cunio reported he had a slow week with only 3 medical calls. He did say that more propane tanks had been removed from Cody but 15 remain. He will keep calling Rhymes to get removed. He also reviewed the on line fire permits and adjustments being made so there is no confusion and that they are just seasonal permits.

Meeting adjourned at 7:15pm.
