Public Hearing for Proposed changes to Section 310.1.5 and Section 304.6.7

With a quorum having been declared the meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Chairmen Anne Cunningham presiding.

A special meeting was held to vote on whether or not to put on the March ballot, the proposed changes to 10% Lot Coverage and Impervious Surfaces on Shorefront Lots. The two proposed changes are linked. The proposal is to relax the rule that restricts structures to 10% of the lot while increasing the state's minimum requirements for stormwater management on shorefront lots to protect water quality.

Public Hearing opened at 7:01 p.m.

There was no public present for the hearing. However, Anne read a letter from Don Harris supporting the proposed changes to sections 310.1.5 and 304.6.7.

Bill reiterated he does not support the proposed changes for the sections above.

After a brief discussion, Anne asked for a motion to put the proposed changes on the March ballot.

Jeffrey made a motion, seconded by Dale to put the proposed changes to sections 310.1.5 and 304.6.7 on the March ballot. Motion passed.

Anne will forward the information on tonight's meeting to Janice and Libby will get the ballot questions.

The Master Plan will be on next months agenda.

There being no other business to come before the board, Bill made a motion, seconded by Jeffrey to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 p.m.
