

Town of Freedom WINTER PARKING BAN

Pursuant to the provisions of RSA 41:8, 41:11, 47:17, and any other applicable Revised Statutes Annotated, the following Board of Selectmen of the Town of Freedom hereby ordain as follows:

Parking Ban – In Effect from November 15 to May 1

From November 15th to May 1st of each year, no person shall park any motor vehicle on any public highway at any time in such a manner as to impede snow plowing, snow removal or road surface treatment operations, or emergency vehicle and/or equipment access.

Information regarding vehicles found impeding winter operations by the Town of Freedom Highway Department or independent contractors engaged by the Town of Freedom Road Agent will be turned over to the Freedom Police Department for disposition.

Any vehicle parked in violation may be authorized to be towed by the Police Chief or his designee. Any vehicles towed shall be stored and released to the owner only upon payment of the cost of towing (as established by the towing firm).

Any person violating the parking ban shall be subject to a penalty not to exceed \$100.00 for each offence in addition to any other costs associated with the removal of the vehicle.

This policy shall be reviewed by the Board of Selectmen, or its designee, with changes made as warranted, followed by re-adoption by the Board of Selectmen.

The Board of Selectmen reserves the right to implement changes to this policy without prior notice if it is deemed in the Town's best interest.
