Application #21-1-23C Camp Cody Inc

Applicant seeks a special exception to permit the installation of erosion and sediment control measures within the shorefront district for the construction of a new directorial cabin. An additional special exception is sought for the widening of the existing path from 9 feet to 15 feet. The path will be 15' wide in order to provide adequate access to the cabin for emergency vehicles.

Applicant is requesting the following:

Special Exception Article 3 Section 304.6.3 Erosion Control

Property is located at 9 Cody Rd. Map 21 Lot 1 & 1-1

Application # 1-16-23 Carroll County YMCA Inc

Applicant is seeking a special exception to permit the installation of erosion and sediment control measures within the shorefront district for the construction of additions onto the existing Program Lodge building and the installation of a new well and septic system.

Applicant is requesting the following:

Special Exception Article 3 Section 304.6.3 Erosion Control

Property is located at 17 Camp Huckins Rd. Map 1 Lot 16

Chairman Lees called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Public Meeting

Denny Anderson made the motion, seconded by Karl Ogren, to approve the meeting minutes of November 28, 2023 with corrections. All were in favor. APPROVED

Application #21-1-23C Camp Cody Inc.

James Hayden appeared before the board, representing Camp Cody Inc on this application. Applicant is seeing a special exception for the installation of erosion and sediment control within the shorefront district for construction of a new directorial cabin. They are also seeking a special exception to permit the widening of the existing path from 9 feet to 15 feet in order to provide adequate access to the cabin for emergency vehicles. Horizons had a site visit with Freedom Fire Chief Rob Cunio who recommended this expansion of the road in case of an emergency. Due to this the special exception is needed as the road will now disturb the wetlands to be completed.

Board Discussion:

- New cabin sits over from the shed that was approved at last month's meeting.
- Sees no problems with erosion control plan
- Meets all setbacks
- All permits are in process at the state level
- Conditions Obtain state permits (Septic, Wetland, Shoreland), Planning Board Approval
- Clerical error was made on which special exceptions were being sought. 304.6.3 for erosion control for the shorefront erosion control and 405.1 for widening the path through the wetlands. Board sees no problem continuing with the application and plan with this new information.

No abutters or public for comment.

James noted that this application will be presented to the Planning Board for site plan review.
